I am supporting this letter because I believe it is important to communicate with the Department regarding the Board's concerns with how Recommendation 14-1 is being addressed. What is missing from this letter is reference to the August 2016 deficiency report which failed to identify many of the weaknesses that our staff has been reporting on, specifically at the Los Alamos National Laboratory. If the deficiencies are not reported by the field and/or verified by Headquarters, it is unlikely that Headquarters can adequately address deficiencies and provide proper oversight.

An earlier version of this letter contained a reporting requirement consistent with our statute asking for an updated deficiency report. The current letter fails to do that and I believe is weaker for that.
