**Proposed Amendment:** In section 10. Definitions---Instructions, Notices, Operating Procedures, and Work Practices should be subordinate to Supplementary Documents as each of these represents a document Supplementary to a Directive. Further, it should be noted that in the event that any of these items should be put into place to supplant or replace a Directive, which is a policy document, the same procedures should be used before the Chairman issues a Directive, that is, concurrence of the Board. (This is not necessary if, for instance, a notice is taking the place of an operating procedure or a staff level document, but a Notice cannot serve as a replacement for a Directive absent consent of the Board.)

**Justification:** The Board's statute states that the Board establishes policy on behalf of the Agency.

This is the proposed revised version:

### **DEFINITIONS.**

- A. <u>Directive</u>. The highest level Directives Program document, used to establish or describe policies, programs, and major activities, define requirements, delegate authority, and assign responsibilities. Final Directives are approved by the Board and signed by the Chairman.
- B. <u>Supplementary Documents</u>. A lower tier document developed at the Office level or below to provide detailed requirements, responsibilities, processes, procedures, guidelines and assistance for conducting the Board's or its staff's activities. Final Supplementary Documents are approved by the appropriate level of management whose area of responsibility includes the scope of the Supplementary Document as defined in D-21.1, *Directives Program*, and do not require the Chairman's signature. No supplementary document may replace a Directive nor be a placeholder for a Directive or any item that constitutes a matter of policy without the approval of the Board.
  - i.) <u>Instruction.</u> A Supplementary Document that provides high-level direction for the execution of an Office program or function. Instructions do not assign responsibilities or establish requirements outside of the originating Office and are approved and issued by the Office Director.
  - ii) Notice. A Supplementary Document issued in response to an Agency matter requiring prompt action to establish short-term management

objectives. A Notice must be converted to or incorporated into another Board Directive Program document within one year of the effective date of the Notice unless an extension is granted or the Notice is allowed to expire. A Notice cannot replace nor be a substitute for a Directive without approval of the Board.

- <u>Operating Procedure</u>. A Supplementary Document that implements a
   Directive or Instruction and provides detailed directions or instructions for
   the execution of a Board-wide or Office-wide program or function.
   Operating Procedures are approved by the Office initiating the Procedure
   and may impact employees in all Offices.
- iv) <u>Work Practice</u>. A Supplementary Document that provides guidance to Office staff to support the successful accomplishment of work in a specific type of activity.
