**Justification:** During the reporting period covered by this report to Congress, the Board did not identify any new safety issues with the Waste Treatment and Immobilization Plant at the Hanford site and did not formally communicate to DOE on resolution for the previously identified and still unresolved issues. The Board did forward to DOE a technical report on plugging and wear of process piping at the Waste Treatment and Immobilization Plant for DOE’s information and use to aid DOE in pursuing a path to resolution. The Board has not closed this issue.


