**SUMMARY:** As authorized by 42 U.S.C. 2286b, notice is hereby given of the Defense Nuclear Facilities Safety Board's (Board) public hearing described below. The Board invites any interested persons or groups to present any comments, technical information, or data concerning safety issues related to the matters to be considered.

**TIME AND DATE:** The Secretary of Energy's Session: 12:00 p.m. – 12:45 p.m., Session 1: 12:45 p.m. – 2:15 p.m., Session 2: 2:30 p.m. – 4:00 p.m., September 26, 2017.

**PLACE:** Defense Nuclear Facilities Safety Board Headquarters, 625 Indiana Avenue NW., Washington, D.C. 20004-2901.

## STATUS: Open.

### MATTERS TO BE CONSIDERED:

In this public hearing, the Board wishes to gather information regarding the Department of Energy's (DOE) and the National Nuclear Security Administration's (NNSA) progress in addressing the concerns identified in Board Recommendation 2014-1, *Emergency Preparedness and Response*.

The public hearing will be convened in an afternoon session with three panels. In the first panel, a representative of the Honorable James Richard "Rick" Perry, Secretary, U.S. Department of Energy, will provide testimony concerning the Secretary's position on emergency preparedness at DOE defense nuclear facilities. During Session 1, panelists

will update the Board and the public on their plans and progress in addressing the field and headquarters emergency management operations, including readiness assurance. During Session 2, panelists will inform the Board and the public on DOE and NNSA's progress in addressing the specific sub-recommendations contained in Recommendation 2014-1. The panelists will also discuss how DOE is validating that it is effectively implementing the emergency management improvements at each defense nuclear site. The Board asks that commenters describe the nature and scope of their oral presentations. Those who pre-register will be scheduled to speak first. Individual oral comments may be limited by the time available, depending on the number of persons who register. At the beginning of the hearing, the Board will post a list of speakers at the entrance to the hearing room. Anyone who wishes to comment or provide technical information or data may do so in writing, either in lieu of, or in addition to, making an oral presentation. The Board Members may question presenters to the extent deemed appropriate. Public participation in the hearing will be subject to the participation criteria posted on the Board's website. Written comments and documents will be accepted at the hearing or may be sent to the Board's Washington, DC, office. The Board will hold the hearing record open until October 26, 2017, for the receipt of additional materials.

The hearing will be presented live through internet video streaming. A link to the presentation will be available on the Board's website (www.dnfsb.gov) and a recording will be posted soon after. A transcript of these sessions and the associated correspondence will be made available on the Board's website. The Board specifically reserves its right to further schedule and otherwise regulate the course of the hearing, to recess, reconvene, postpone, or adjourn the hearing, conduct further reviews, and otherwise exercise its authority under the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended.
