#### **Brief description of Requested Action:**

The Board is requested to task the Office of the Technical Director to add a non-discretionary review to the FY18 OTD work plan to evaluate the waste transfer program at the Savanah River Site (SRS) Tank Farms and the effectiveness of the safety controls that are in place. To the extent applicable, the staff should leverage the review of the Hanford Tank Farms Waste Transfer Compatibility Program and any extent of condition and conclusions that may be relevant to SRS. The technical staff shall produce an information paper including their assessment of the waste transfer program and any staff recommendations for additional Board action. This review shall be prioritized so that the review and associated information paper be completed during FY18.

#### Justification:

This issue was raised to the staff by a Board member in June 2016. The staff committed to evaluating this issue as part of the planned SRS Tank Farms DSA review in FY17. When it was not completed in FY17, this DSA review was incorporated in the FY18 work plan. However, staff is currently not planning to accomplish this review. It is important for the Board to be informed on the adequacy of safety controls associated with waste transfer activities and identify any potential safety risks in a timely manner.
