Justification:

It is inappropriate to invoke Exemption (9)(B) of the Government in the Sunshine Act (5 U.S.C. § 552b(c)(9)(B)). This exemption is redundant to Exemption (3) prior to the Board's decision on a Recommendation, and it is not applicable once the Board has decided. Including it as an exemption might advance the erroneous interpretation that the information could be withheld from the public even after the Board had acted in order not to frustrate DOE's action, but the "proposed agency action" listed in (9)(B) is the Board's action, not DOE's response to it.
