The information on pp. 58-59, in the section discussing the Board's FY14 accomplishments towards meeting Performance Goal 4.1.3, is incorrect. To satisfy the goal, <u>new</u> procedures needed to be developed and implemented within OGC. The Board reports that OGC work on three issues results in 21% completion towards a milestone, but the work done did not result in any new procedures. A correct report would indicate that no progress was made.

I approve the budget request because we must have one, but I am disappointed that my proposed amendment (Doc#2015-047A) did not pass. The amendment sought to correct the discussion on Performance Goal 4.1.3. I raised the same issue last November when the Board submitted its FY14 Performance and Accountability Report (See Doc#2015-022A and Doc#2015-022). Accuracy is important to credibility, and I am puzzled as to why the Board continues to report incorrect information.
