The graph in the proposed Amendment provides an oversimplified visual narrative of a trend while failing to explain why it has happened, leading the viewer to the erroneous conclusion of concern about spending per FTE. Not explained are many elements driving these numbers, such as timing of capital and other discrete expenses. Most importantly, it is a fact of basic arithmetic that when FTE count declines, as it has during the past years, the fixed costs of a financial unit will necessarily drive spending per FTE upward. This graph, while technically accurate, is so over-simplified as to be extremely misleading.

I therefore disapprove.




