Washington, DC—Executive Director of Operations Joel C. Spangenberg is pleased to announce the assignment of Mr. Andrew Kline as Resident Inspector at the Department of Energy’s (DOE) Savannah River Site (SRS) near Aiken, SC. Mr. Kline will join Mr. Zachary McCabe, Ms. Leigh Lin and Mr. Eric Richardson, the Board’s current Resident Inspectors at SRS, starting on May 23, 2022.

As a Resident Inspector, Mr. Kline will advise the Board on the overall safety conditions of defense nuclear facilities at SRS and will participate in technical reviews by the Board and its staff related to the design, construction, operation, and decommissioning of defense nuclear facilities. He will also act as the Board’s liaison with SRS management, state and local agencies, the public, and industry officials.

Mr. Kline joins the Board after working at SRS since 2015 where he held multiple roles including Design Engineer, Operations Process Manager, and, most recently, Project Manager. During his time at SRS, Mr. Kline was responsible for safety basis development, facility design, and Plutonium processing operations to support nonproliferation.

Mr. Kline holds a Bachelor of Science degree in Mechanical Engineering from the Pennsylvania State University at Harrisburg and a Master of Business Administration degree from University of South Carolina Aiken.
