I do not agree with the basic premise of this amendment that Board recommendations are not effective. The suggestion that Recommendation 2004-1, *Oversight of Complex, High-Hazard Nuclear Operations*, was not effective is completely wrong. Recommendation 2004-1 was a benchmark recommendation that reinvigorated Integrated Safety Management. It was held open for a long period of time to address one aspect of the recommendation that dealt with nuclear safety R&D. In the last two years, the Board has done a much better job of closing recommendations that lingered because a small part of the Implementation Plan was not complete.

By very rough OTD estimates, the study will take a significant amount of Board resources. I do not believe this expenditure of resources is justified and will detract for the Board accomplishing its mission to provide adequate protection of public and worker safety.
