I disapprove because the proposed agenda focuses solely on the issue of waste management at LANL's Area G. That issue, while important, is not the most significant issue at Los Alamos threatening the public health and safety. Moreover, the risk to the public, which stems from the potential for a WIPP-like chemical reaction, is less today than it was two years ago, and it will reduce further still with the passage of time. 'Risk' is a function of probability multiplied by consequence. While consequence may be high, the probability seems to me to be low and getting lower. I do not understand why after two years of improvements in the situation the Area G issue has suddenly eclipsed all others of concern to the DNFSB.
