While I supported the work plan in its original form, the amendments that have been added undermine the work of the technical staff to be able to optimally perform its job to oversee the Department of Energy's defense nuclear facilities and adequately protect the public. By adding "priority one" tasks that are administrative in nature and directing the Technical Director to move resources from other priority work for these endeavors, the Board has removed the discretion of the SES leadership corps to appropriately staff and resource safety issues. Other amendments significantly limit staff's ability to examine safety issues that could directly impact the adequate protection of co-located workers and the general public. Therefore, I cannot support the OTD Work Plan in its amended form.

I support the Board, as a whole, revisiting the prioritization approach approved for staff use but not reprioritizing specific activities based on individual Board Member's preference. It creates an unclear picture of what nuclear safety oversight will be pursued and how it is prioritized against preferential activities with no definable safety implications.

I believe there is an imbalance between shadowing DOE or its contractors and independent evaluations. We could be more selective and limited in shadowing activities based on the presence of Site Reps and confidence in field or project oversight.

I believe staff technical expertise development and enhancement, as it relates to safety in the DOE complex and the ability to oversee and effectively gather information in the DOE/NNSA field environment needs to be better accounted for to ensure the appropriate investment is made in light of the significant growth and change in our staff. This is essential to maintain the Board's reputation of unchallenged technical excellence by DOE, Congress, and the public.
